Dear Pharmacovigilantes!

You are receiving this information as part of your subscription to the Pharmacovigilance e-shot that you have showed interest in.

It has come to our notice that the following medicine has a quality problem in the **public sector**:

Name of Product: Paracetamol 500mg Tablets.

Batch numbers: 081201 and 090106

Packing size: Pack of 1000

Manufactured by: Shangai Pharma Ind. Ltd, China.

Nature of complaint: Tablets are moulding and discolored.

Distribution: Public Sector

As investigations are ongoing, we ask you to:

1. Immediately quarantine the above batches.
2. Please reconcile your stocks immediately (how many you received, dispensed, balance, how many with above complaint etc) and revert to KEMSA or PPB.
3. Return the affected batches to the nearest KEMSA depot, with appropriate documentation.
4. Verify if there is a problem (similar or otherwise) with other batches you may have of the same product.

Further information will be communicated as investigations proceed.
